With the holiday season coming the 6th division would like to offer you some crime prevention tips for Auto Thefts and Thefts from Auto's. In an effort to assist us in combating these crimes of opportunity, we ask that you review the listed crime prevention tips. Although these tips cannot guarantee that you will not become a victim of a crime, they may greatly decrease your chances dramatically.

- Make sure that all vehicle windows and doors are properly secured.
- Do not leave your vehicle running unattended. Not only does this invite thieves, but it is a violation of the law and you may be cited or fined.
- Look out for your neighbor's vehicles.
- Invest in and use an anti-theft devise or audible car alarm.
- Park in your garage if possible or in a well lit area.
- Keep valuables and packages out of plain view. Purses, wallets, cell phones, guns, and GPS systems are a prime target and <u>should not</u> be kept in your vehicle. If you must keep items in your vehicle remember to <u>"put your junk in your trunk".</u>
- Do not hide a key in your car or under the hood
- If you have a detachable face place stereo, please remove it when you exit your vehicle.
- Keep serial/model numbers of any aftermarket audio equipment that you purchase
- Notify the police if you notice suspicious activity. Especially subjects whom may be loitering near vehicles.
