**TAX ORDINANCES**

Ms. Garrett gave second reading by title and attorney-drafted summary to Ordinance No. 271, Series 2023, regarding the assessment of all real property and the levy of tax thereon at a rate of 5.7¢ per \$100 of assessed valuation for fiscal year July 1, 2023, to June 30, 2024; seconded by Mr. Johnson. There being no further discussion, the motion was brought to a roll-call vote. Voting yea were Jay Bourke, Gina Garrett, Phil Johnson, and Marlene Welsh. There were no nays or abstentions. Motion carried with a vote of 4-0.

Mr. Johnson gave second reading by title and attorney-drafted summary to Ordinance No. 272, Series 2023, regarding the assessment of all motor vehicles and watercraft and the levy of tax thereon at a rate of 7.0¢ per \$100 of assessed valuation for the year 2024; seconded by Mr. Bourke. There being no further discussion, the motion was brought to a roll-call vote. Voting yea were Jay Bourke, Gina Garrett, Phil Johnson, and Marlene Welsh. There were no nays or abstentions. Motion carried with a vote of 4-0.

Mrs. Welsh gave second reading by title and attorney-drafted summary to Ordinance No. 273, Series 2023, regarding the assessment of all taxable tangible personal property and the levy of tax thereon at a rate of 5.0¢ per \$100 of assessed valuation for fiscal year July 1, 2023, to June 30, 2024; seconded by Ms. Garrett. There being no further discussion, the motion was brought to a roll-call vote. Voting yea were Jay Bourke, Gina Garrett, Phil Johnson, and Marlene Welsh. There were no nays or abstentions. Motion carried with a vote of 4-0.
