BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF WATTERSON PARK:

<u>SECTION TWO</u>: This budget ordinance shall be administered by the executive authority as described and set forth in the Kentucky Revised Statutes. Administration shall include, but not be limited to, at least the following:

- A. Prepare and submit financial statements which include budgetary comparisons on not less than a quarterly basis.
- B. Provide for budget amendments if called for by the council or if anticipated through implementation.
- C. Prepare any financial statements required for publication purposes, pursuant to KRS Chapters 424 and 91A.
- D. Cause each fund of this budget to be audited as prescribed by law.

SECTION THREE: This Ordinance shall be published by title and summary within thirty (30) days after adoption.

<u>SECTION FOUR</u>: This Ordinance becomes effective immediately upon passage and publication as required by law.
