EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 2026-001

By the authority vested in the Mayor of the City of Watterson Park and to provide for the orderly continuation of the function of the City government during such time(s) as the Mayor is unable to attend to the duties of her office, the Mayor hereby orders as follows:

1. Delegable Duties Defined. The term “delegable duties” means all duties, functions, and responsibilities of the office of Mayor that can be delegated consistent with KRS 83A.130(7) and (10) during such time(s) as the Mayor is unable to attend to the duties of her office.
2. Primary Delegation. The Mayor hereby delegates to Aggie Keefe, the City Clerk, all delegable duties during such time(s) as the Mayor is unable to attend to the duties of her office.
3. Contingent Delegation. The Mayor hereby delegates to Jean Hall, the City Treasurer, all delegable duties Aggie Keefe is unavailable, unable, or unwilling to perform during such time(s) as the Mayor is unable to attend to the duties of her office.
4. Delegation Does Not Diminish Duties of City Clerk or City Treasurer. Solely for the purpose of clarity, the Mayor states that the none of the above delegations reduces, diminishes, or impinges upon the duties, functions, and responsibilities of either the City Clerk or the City Treasurer.
